### Legislative Action Network Resources Available to Empower YOU!

While your ISBA lobby team strives to be in the right place at the right time, we are more effective when our efforts are complemented by a troop of school board members participating in the **Legislative Action Network (LAN)**, ISBA's formal grassroots advocacy program. The LAN is designed to help unify and mobilize "the voice" of school board members and increase State House impact. Through this program, we provide you with the information, resources, strategies, and guidance to engage in the grassroots advocacy process. Here is a summary of the resources available to you to empower you and amplify your voice.

#### Weekly Legislative Updates

Every Friday for the duration of the session, ISBA will email a recap of key activity transpiring that week and will preview the week ahead. When critical votes occur, roll calls will be provided so you can see how your area legislators voted. All weekly legislative updates are posted online.

#### Bill Tracking List

Keep tabs on the status of legislation with ISBA's comprehensive Bill Tracking List. The list is updated in real time whenever action on a bill is taken. A link to this free resource may be found in the ISBA Weekly Legislative Updates and on our Legislative Services Web Page.

#### Call-to-Action Alerts

When critical votes are pending, ISBA will email you with specific advocacy requests. It is important that ISBA members act on these alerts immediately and typically within 24 hours to help achieve the desired legislative outcomes.
